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Anticipating the October 5-8 Meeting on Jekyll Island

Facilities and the Island: Jekyll Island is undergoing a renovation/construction project that will reduce services on the island in the fall of 2010. Presently, there is no gasoline sold on the island, and there is no pharmacy. The small shopping area will be moved into temporary housing (that will be nearer to the Oceanside Inn and Suites). Dining facilities will be limited, and therefore, all of our meals will be served buffet style in the “Quarterdeck.” There is a restaurant adjacent to the lodging at Oceanside for those who choose not to pay for the buffet meals. The golf courses are in excellent condition, but most of us won’t have time for golfing.

Meeting Space: The meeting space is essentially the same as the last time we met at Oceanside. However, this year certification sub-committees and some of the Peer Review committees will meet in the sitting areas of rooms 204-212. The certification hospitality room will be 208. All of these rooms are located south of the registration lobby, and they are to be entered from the ocean side. Check the posters locating your meeting space that will be located at the registration desk.

Reimbursement Policy: For persons serving on standing committees, the reimbursement of travel expense at \$.50 per mile or airfare whichever is least expensive; actual expense of lodging if the room is shared by two members of standing committees, or one half the cost of lodging for single occupants, and actual cost of meals for persons serving on standing committees.

The actual cost of meals will be charged to the master account at this meeting, and members of standing committees are expected to have the following meals served buffet style in the Quarterdeck: CC on Tuesday evening and Wednesday breakfast; ADM BD, CC and Peer Review on Wednesday lunch; all standing committees Wednesday dinner, Thursday breakfast and lunch.

****Individuals pay for Thursday dinner (\$20), Friday breakfast (\$12) and lunch (\$15); but reservations for these buffet meals must be made through Jap Keith by September 24. Fifty-five persons registered for the continuing education program have not reserved these meals. If you can’t get the payment to me, please email me directions for your reservations. The Inn insists on prior notice for buffet meals.****

Business Meeting: From 8 until 10 am on Friday there will be opportunities for conversations about the future of our work together. The chairpersons of standing committees and the representatives to the ACPE Board of Representatives have been asked to present their reports in writing for distribution prior to this appointed time. Included in this newsletter are the nominations of persons who have consented to serve if elected.

At 10:30 am on Friday the Annual Members’ Meeting will be called to order.

Among other decisions the body politic might make, we will be asked to

- elect our officers and committee members
- adopt a budget for 2011 and a projected budget for 2012
- take action on a revision of the Policy and Procedures and Guidelines for Peer Reviews
- decide on the location of our Members’ Meeting in 2013
- take action to ratify the Adm Bd reappointment of Jasper N. Keith, Jr. as the RD for a five year term, effective January 1, 2011.

I want to express appreciation to everyone for their cooperation in structuring the many demands upon us at this regional meeting. On Sep 10, we have 57 registered for continuing event with 21 promises. ***I need your meal reservations!!!*** Please let me know that you received this newsletter, especially if you have any questions about the structuring of our life and work October 5-8, 2010.
