CONTINUING EDUCATION at Epworth-by-the-Sea

October 4 & 5, 2013

Dr. Joretta Marshall, Dean and Professor of Pastoral Theology and Pastoral Counseling at Brite Divinity, addressed the theme ***CREATIVITY AS SELF CARE***.

Karen Heistand, Candidate from NE FL Hospice, led worship. **Edna Bacon** led a workshop on Creativity in Art. **Chuck Christie** and **Bob Duvall**, BCC from Gwinnett Medical Center, led a workshop on Creativity in Poetry.

Eugene Robinson was this year's recipient of the *J. Obert Kempson Distinguished Service Award*.

The minutes of the Annual Members' Meeting and the elected leadership of officers and committees were emailed via the listserv on October 8. Among the **actions taken** were:

- (1)** the *adoption of a \$195,250 budget* that included \$15,000 for an Invitational for Supervisors' of SESs, \$2,500 for depositing historical documents on the website and in Pitts' Library, \$4,500 for scholarships to support attendance at REM Invitational, \$3,500 for each SES Consortiums in FL, Interstate, and SC, and \$500 for Webinar/Forum costs;
- (2)** the *elections of Larry Wagoner* as Chairperson-Elect, of **Amanda Jones** as our ACPE Board of Rep in class of 2015, and of **Jim Taylor** for the ACPE Emerging Leader Award; and
- (3)** the *selection of Epworth-by-the-Sea* as the location for the **Fall Regional Meeting in 2015**.

Tom Summers (retired Supervisor of Columbia, SC) was given a *Distinguished Service Award* by Candler School of Theology for his *Service to the Community*. Tom was honored for being "deeply involved with social justice issues, including advocacy for gay rights, immigration reform and racial healing."
