## **SERACPE SUPERVISORY INVITATIONAL**

**January 12 - 14, 2014**

**Twenty-four ACPE Supervisors from the Southeast Region gathered at Epworth by the Sea for the second annual Supervisory Invitational. William DeLong, ACPE from the Pacific Region led the group in learning about 1) the Purpose and Value of Curriculum, 2) the Aims and Goals of Curriculum, 3) the Content of Curriculum, and 4) the Purpose and Form of Evaluation. Bill grounds his perspectives in “transformative learning” theory, and he is an advocate of “educating for certification.” Briefly stated, Bill proposes that “the art of supervision is taught through a Supervisory CPE Curriculum,” and “that ‘art’ is ‘demonstrated’ through the staged certification process of the ACPE and assessed and validated by the ACPE Certification Commission.”**

**The participants at this invitational will advocate for another invitational at the same time and place in 2015.**

REM XXVII was held in the Hilton Charlotte Executive Park Hotel in Charlotte, NC. Around two hundred attendees gathered from lectures, workshops, business, and networking. Two of the four officers of REM Network are from the Southeast (Rhonda Daniels and Bridget Piggue).

The Southeast Region awarded scholarships to thirty-two students in support of their participation. I learned from the presenters, but I was particularly impressed with University of North Carolina Professor Lisa R. Merriweather, Ph.D., whose address was entitled “When Drums and Sticks Talk: Listening to the Polyrhythms.” “Polyrhythms” are the simultaneous use of two or more conflicting rhythms that are not readily perceived as deriving from one another. Learning the art of playing “cross-beats” while fully grounded in the main beats prepares one for maintaining a life-purpose while dealing with life’s challenges.”
